

#### September 2017

While September is seven months away, planning for the next school year is under way. The process began with our kindergarten registration week during the second to last week of January and we currently have 34 kindergarten students registered for September. We also had the K - 12 transfer process in mid-February and as part of this process, we request that any families in grades K - 4 who will not be returning to Eagle View in September please inform the school. We will assume all our grade 5 students will be transitioning to Colquitz Middle School unless we hear otherwise. Please let us know if your plans are not to be at Eagle View next September. Thank you.

**Kindergarten to Grade 5 Registration for new students** - continues for children who are new to our school catchment. When registering, please bring: Proof of Citizenship (Birth Certificate or Landed Immigrant Status), proof of residency e.g., hydro bill, driver's license and your child's BC Medical Card. If you have any questions, please contact the office.

#### Staying Healthy

We are experiencing a lot of colds and flu for students, their families and staff. Please talk with your child about the importance of proper hand washing and coughing/sneezing into their elbow.

#### How to Wash Hands:

Wet hands under warm running water

Scrub with plain soap for a count of 20, all over hands and between fingers

Rinse under running water for a count of 10

Dry hands with a clean paper towel

**Turn** off taps with a paper towel



If your child has been home, or goes home from school with a fever or has been vomiting or has diarrhea, it is suggested that they be free from symptoms for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school. If your child has been up in the night with any of these symptoms, please do your best to make arrangements for them to stay home until it is certain they have been healthy for at least 24 hours. This will hopefully lessen the spread of illness throughout the school.
