New Business

- This emergency PAC meeting was called to consider purchase of silent bike trainers for the school's classrooms and library.
- PAC has been requested to consider purchasing additional bikes for the school, to supplement the single bike currently owned. A district-wide purchase order is scheduled to be submitted on Monday, January 14, 2019.
- Available to all students, these bikes contribute to the learning style of individual kids, allowing physical activity while still learning and being involved in classroom lessons.
- The bike is not a punishment tool, but rather it becomes a positive addition to the classroom that teaches responsibility, ownership and self-regulation.
- Use of the bike helps kids get focused and ready to learn.
- Bikes are ordered by School District.
- PAC funds are currently being raised for future purchase of playground equipment; purchasing these indoor bikes will not impede this long-term goal.

Motion to allow purchase of five (5) silent bikes for Eagle View Elementary School put forward by Mel Evans; motion seconded by Meredith Walker.
