New Business

- Looking for people to join 2019/20 PAC
- Discussed possible fundraising ideas: Paint Nite event, Boston Pizza hosting event (volunteers deliver pizzas to customers' tables)
- Ideas were discussed for a Type 1 diabetes walk to raise money for JDRF (Juvenile Diabetes Research Fund), request to engage EVE in awareness/education of illness and fundraising walk, Becky and Kohl to organize event, walk June 9th. Additionally, Young Entrepreneurs Fair with Grade 4/5 in May could be possible means to raise additional funds

We need a team of dedicated volunteers (4) to orchestrate and facilitate plan for acquisition of new playground and rubber play surface. Playground must be tendered and detailed rules must be followed. EVE can also apply for Stewardship grant.
