Eagle View Elementary Student Expectations at School during COVID

Your child will be coming into the school in order to receive in-person learning beginning the week of June 1. In order to ensure the safety of all staff and students, <u>please review these expectations with your child</u> <u>prior to them coming to school.</u>

Expectations before coming to school

- 1. If the student or ANYONE IN THE HOUSEHOLD feels ill or has any symptoms of illness, the student will not come to school.
- 2. Students are invited into the school for learning and/or counseling support on a scheduled basis, which will be confirmed with parents. The agreed-upon schedule can only be changed with the Principal's permission.

Arrival at School

- At all times (even outside) students and adults are encouraged to maintain a 6ft (2m) distance from anyone else not in their family. For elementary age students, the focus will be on maintaining a safe physical distance whenever possible and reducing physical contact with one another as per BCCDC and Ministry of Health Guidelines (updated May 14, 2020)
- Parents will not be able to enter the building with their child.
- > Students will line up in their designated areas. Look for red tape on the ground for their division.
- **Kindergarten**: will line up by the bike racks, with social distancing markers on the ground. Mrs. Coleman's class will be along the building. Ms. Moore's class along the bike racks.
- ➤ Christoff/Kennell/Gregory: will line up on the asphalt in 2 rows of five looking for the red tape to indicate their division. Social distancing markers will be on the ground. See attached map
- Rutherford/Smith: will line up on the asphalt alongside the playground equipment. Look for the red tape to indicate their division. Social distancing markers will be on the ground. See attached map.
- ➤ Galhon/Brain/Nast/Borich: will line up on the basketball court like we do for fire drills. Look for the red tape that indicates where your division is and each line will have social distancing markers on the ground. See attached map.
- A staff member will walk out to receive the class. Please be prepared to answer some health related questions upon entry to school each day. Students must enter the building under the supervision of an adult, keeping six feet apart from one another.
- > Students must go directly to their assigned room, keeping 6ft apart from others and not touching anything along the way.
- Once in their assigned classroom they will place their belongings at their desk and wait to be called over to the sink to wash their hands.
- Sink area is to be disinfected after each student use (washing hands, filling of water bottles)

While at school

There are clear safety protocols that must be followed at all times while on school property or in the school:

- > Students will be supported to keep 6ft distance from each other whenever possible. For elementary age students, the focus will be on maintaining a safe physical distance whenever possible and reducing physical contact with one another.
- Everyone will wash hands with soap for a minimum of 20 seconds after using the washroom or after returning to class. Singing of the ABC song may help students wash for the appropriate amount of time. Students must use only the student washrooms. Students will be accompanied to and from the washroom by a staff member to ensure no more than 3 students at a time are using the washroom.
- > Students will only engage with or use their personally designated resources/materials (ie. bucket with their name on it containing their learning materials). They are not to touch any other items/materials in the room without staff permission.
- Students must follow staff direction and requests at all times.

Materials at School

- > Students may bring items from home that support their learning or emotional health. These items should be small enough to fit in their learning space and can include such things as a lunch kit (pack in pack out garbage system remains), small toys for imaginative play etc. All items must be kept at the student's learning space. We are discouraging the use of large back packs as we do not have the space to keep them.
- > Grade 3-5 students are asked to bring a device they have been using for their home learning if possible, charged and ready to go.
- > Students are to bring their own water bottle to and from school. Water bottles should not be left at school.
- > Water bottles are to be filled in the classroom fountains only
- > School provided learning materials will remain at each student's desk and not be shared with other students. Materials will be disinfected regularly by the staff in the room.

Not Following Expectations

If a student is repeatedly not following safety protocols the Principal/Vice Principal will be notified and asked to assist. Parents may be called if this becomes a common occurrence.

Leaving school

- > Students will leave the school via the doors they came in under the supervision of an adult.
- Parents must be on site at pick up time unless other arrangements have been made with the classroom teacher (ie students who walk home).
- At all times (even outside), students and adults will be encouraged to maintain a 6ft (2m) distance from anyone else not in their family.
- Playgrounds are still closed, so thank you for heading home promptly.
