Hello Eagle View Students!

Our province has done a great job of flattening the COVID-19 curve by staying at home and keeping physically distanced from one another.

You and some of your classmates might be coming back and some things are going to look a little different inside and outside of the school.



Everyone will have an assigned entrance and exit door depending on which class you are in.

This is to help us keep high traffic areas sanitized and organized.

There will be red lines taped on the ground outside. Please line up with your class at your divisions line and a staff member will come pick you up when it is your time to come inside.

Remember to space yourself far enough away from the person in front of you by using the red lines.





There is a table set up inside the front door with supplies to keep our school clean and safe. This area is for adults. If you need anything, please ask an adult.



The office is closed right now. If you need help please stop outside the office door say "Hi" and wait for someone to come and talk to you.

The first thing you will do when you enter the school is wash your hands in your classroom.

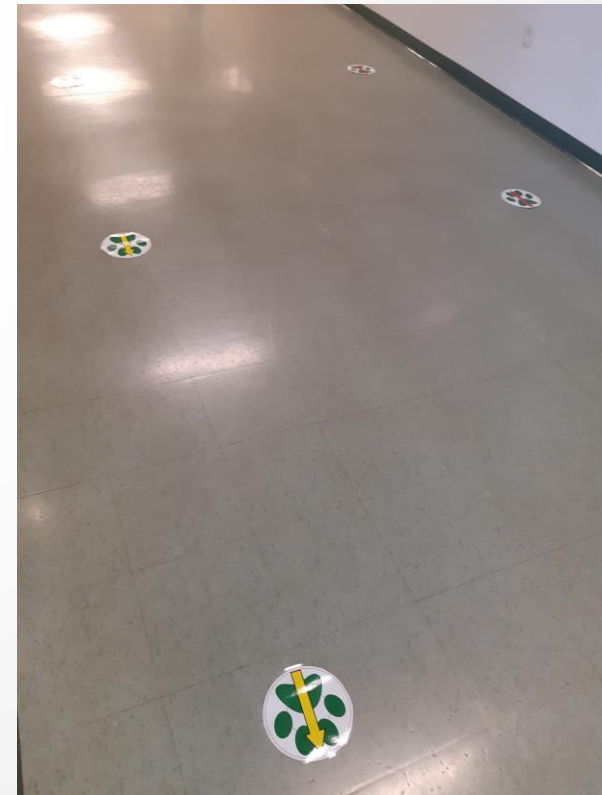
Scrub well with soap for 20 seconds and rinse with water. Don't forget to use a paper towel to dry your hands!



If you need to use the washroom during the day an adult will come with you to wipe down the washroom after you are done.



You will notice arrows on the floor that tell you where to walk in the halls. The hallways are divided to make sure we are able to keep our distance from others. Stay to the right side of the hallways and follow the arrows to where you need to go.



In some spots in our hallways you will notice different markings. Please make sure you follow the directions.

You will notice a circle of arrows where the three hallways meet outside of the gym.



You will also notice blue tape with yield signs on either sides of the doors in the hallways. Please wait at the blue line if there is someone coming the other way. Only one person can walk through the doorway at a time.

Remember to cover your coughs and sneezes (with your elbow or a tissue), to wash your hands often, and try not to touch your face.



The desks are spaced out so that you each have your own learning area. There will be less students in each class than before.

Your desk will be labelled with your name. This is where you can keep all of your learning tools and belongings from home.

Your backpacks, coats, and hats will be kept at your desk area during the day along with your school work.





Please bring a water bottle that you've filled up at home because we cannot use the water fountains in the hallways at school. The only place to fill up your bottle is at the sink in your classroom.

All classrooms will have disinfectant spray bottles for adults to use, as well as hand sanitizer so we can keep our hands germ free.



You might not be outside at the same time as your friends from other classes and we can't use the playground equipment right now, but there are lots of other areas to play, like the blacktop, the outdoor sensory circuit, and the school field!

We need to remember to keep physical distance from each other when we line up to go back inside.
