
Thank you, as well, to the many parents who go the extra mile: organizing and contributing to PAC meetings; creating fundraising projects; ... and the list goes on.

Kindergarten Registration - September 2021

Planning is already underway for Kindergarten registration. Children turning 5 years old in the calendar year 2021 are eligible for Kindergarten in September 2021. Registration week is Monday, January 25 through Friday, January 29, 2021.

Please read the following carefully for enrolment priorities as well as the documentation required to register.

Families are asked to register online for their catchment area school during registration week. If you currently have a student at Eagle View and will be registering a Kindergarten student but are **not** living in the Eagle View catchment you must register online for your catchment school and apply for a transfer to Eagle View.

To register you will need your child's birth certificate, Canadian Passport or landed immigrant authorization. You will need to provide <u>two</u> of the following documents for proof of residency (driver's license and utility bills will no longer be accepted):

<u>Home owners</u> <u>Renters</u>

purchase agreement of home
current property tax statement
home owner's insurance
notice of assessment
a purchase agreement (w/subject removal & deposit receipt)

rental agreement signed by landlord &
2 of the following:
Canadian bank or credit card statement
BC vehicle registration
income tax statement
renter insurance documents
