Thank you for your continued support from home. We want to wish you and your family a safe, FUN and Happy Spring Break!

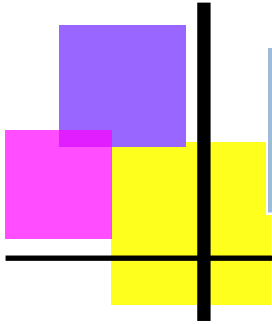

Staying Healthy

We are experiencing a lot of colds and flu for students, their families and staff. Please talk with your child about the importance of proper hand washing and coughing/sneezing into their elbow.

How to Wash Hands:

Wet hands under warm running water

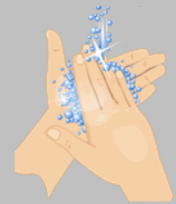
Scrub with plain soap for a count of **20**, all over hands and between fingers

Rinse under running water for a count of **10**

Dry hands with a clean paper towel

Turn off taps with a paper towel

If your child has been home, or goes home from school with a fever or has been vomiting or has diarrhea, it is suggested that they be free from symptoms for a minimum of 24 hours before returning to school. If your child has been up in the night with any of these symptoms, please do your best to make arrangements for them to stay home until it is certain they have been healthy for at least 24 hours. This will hopefully lessen the spread of illness throughout the school.

All rocky hills on the school property (in the kindergarten yard and in the back main forest area) are out of bounds between 8:30 am and 3:00 pm. Please help us by keeping your children safe by staying off of these areas at the drop off and pick up times. They are very slippery and dangerous. Thank you!
