### **Principal's Report:**

- First full week back is going well- attendance seems pretty good at this point.
- A few minor changes have been in accordance to the new COVID Protocols- focus is on spacing the students out outside. The school is hoping to start some inside options for recess periods as well. These may start as early as next week.
- Art Starts is booked for May at this point. Hopefully it can be held outdoors.
- Pink, White and Red Day is being planned for Valentine's Day.
- Family Literacy Day is January 27<sup>th</sup>- plans TBA.

**Woodworking Kit Requests:** The PAC voted in favour of spending up to \$1140 towards Woodworking Kits. Six classes will receive the kits (the cost of 1 of the kits was already covered by the school.)

### **Treasurer's Report:**

- We have received gaming funds for this year. We have spent about \$900 from gaming funds this year to cover events like Welcome Back, Halloween Stations, Christmas etc.
- \$1100 is being reserved for the Art Starts Program if we can do it this year.
- We can only save up to 3 years' worth of gaming funds, so we may need to make some purchases out of this fund before the end of the school year.

**Fun Lunches:** We are still looking for vendors- many places are not available due to staffing issues. As we continue to look for vendors, keep in mind that we need vendors who will label the lunches for us. If a vendor can also deliver, that would be an added bonus.

**Parent Education Fund:** We have received the \$250 grant. We will book the workshop *Learning Curve on Challenging Behaviours in Young Children*. Zoe is working on finding a date that works for the presenter and confirming the booking.

**Fundraising:**

- Our Bottle Drive was last Saturday- we are just waiting to hear how much we raised. It was an easy fundraiser that we learned a couple things from. We will consider doing a second one in the spring
- We are looking into the Value Village- Spring Cleaning Fundraiser for after Spring Break. Santana is looking into this and will report back.

**Discussion Items:**

- A general discussion was had about the playground zones that have been put in place. The school's Joint Health and Safety Committee has planned for the playground zones to be in place for 5 weeks and then will reassess the situation.
- A general discussion regarding COVID-19 was had. We discussed our feelings and concerns regarding this ever changing situation. We discussed how we can best support each other, our teachers and our children. Connection and communication are important at this time.
