## Principal's Address (Jana)

- Thank you for the Meet the Teacher cake and welcome. It was wonderful to see the turn out.
- Thank you to Santina for coming to our staff meeting today and to Shawn, Alexis, and Lisa for coming to our Ready, Step and Roll walk-about last week. We are looking forward to working with our community partners to keep students and their families safe. Even though we have one of the largest school parking lots in our district, there is still room for improvement. Areas of concern are parking on yellow lines which create unsafe crossings in the parking lot, parking in front of the yellow gate on Burnside where it says no parking, parking on the side of the road on Burnside which blocks traffic, etc. There will be some changes that View Royal will do with signage. They will continue to support parking on Watkiss as long as it does not block the bike lanes. More people are walking in from this area, so thank you!!!
- Next week is Walk or Ride to School Week.
- Thank you for considering busses for our classrooms, each bus costs between \$300-\$400 depending on where they are going if we are using district busses. Other bus companies are more expensive.
- Cross Country has been a hit this year with more runners than ever. They will conclude on October 25th up near UVIC.
- The running club will start up in November. The parking lot will be closed at recess time to allow the students to run safely.
- Feeding the Future - this week we started serving a simple breakfast, fruit, yogurt, toast, and bagel combination. The first day was slow but it is picking up. No student should start the day hungry! Fruit snacks are available in a basket at the entranceway and can be accessed anytime during the day. The fridge also has food in it and students can access that by asking an adult who will go with them.
- Parent Connect Reminder - This is where parents will receive report cards and can allow their child access to online apps and programs that support learning. If anyone has problems connecting, please call the office.
- Planners arrived today and should be in use soon. There was a fire at the warehouse, so they were delayed this year. Please review the school code of conduct on page 2 with your child or you can find it on our school website
- Emergency drills - we had our first fire drill, and it went really well. We have one a month, 2 earthquake drills a year and one lockdown drill a year.
