November 13, 2024

Meeting was called to order by Santina Spencer.

Principal's report

- Pancake breakfast will be held on the last day of school before Christmas break, on Friday December 20th. The kids will get their pancakes served in the gym and then will eat in their classrooms.
 - There will be a call for parent volunteers to help closer to the date
 - A list of ingredients will be provided to parents and teachers to address allergy concerns, and a volunteer will be providing gluten free pancakes.
- There is a request for feedback on the school goal of supporting students in their reading, writing, and comprehension skills.
- The Gates are closed during recess for running club until end of November
- Drawing club will be starting up again soon.
- The field will be closed soon for winter to protect the grass.
- Art start is coming up, but no dates yet.

Financial Update

- The community values coupon book raised \$4988.
- The Halloween dance made \$2858.
- The gaming rant report has been finished and will be sent out soon.
- The Art Cards and purdies fundraisers will be closing soon, but there are no fundraising numbers available yet.

Movie Night

- Movie night will be taking place next Thursday, the 21st of November, from 6 to 8 pm, showing *Smallfoot*.
 - Currently, there are 15 volunteers, which would allow space for 120 kids. However, not all of the volunteers have criminal records checks in place, and might not be cleared in time.
 - Popcorn will be available for sale.
 - Physical tickets will be sold, with a sign up in advance, and payment at the door.

- Another volunteer request will be sent out on Friday, and more spots will be opened if there are more volunteers.

Home Alone Course

- There are “home alone” courses being offered locally to teach kids safety and babysitting basics, including from a local company, Ready Set Kidz, and from the Juan de Fuca Recreation Center.
 - Ready Set Kidz has a program that would take place on the school campus for 69\$ per student.
 - Juan de Fuca recreation center does their programs in house, at 39\$ per student.
 - The PAC is currently still investigating whether we should offer or support attendance at either of these courses.
