Winter Concerts

All classes will be performing in a Winter Concert on **Thursday, December 18**. We will have two opportunities for parents/families to see the performances. Our afternoon performance will be at 1:15 p.m. and the evening performance will be at 6:00 p.m. All classes will be performing at both performances. For the evening performance, the **front doors of the school will not open until 5:45 p.m.** To avoid disrupting the performance we request the audience stay for the entire performance. **Parking is allowed on Watkiss Way on the day and evening of the performances. Please do not park in staff parking spaces, bike lanes or fire lanes and do not block driveways.**

Concert Ticket Procedure:

- Tickets will not be necessary for the afternoon performance. We encourage grandparents and other extended family members to try to come to this performance.
- Each family will receive two tickets for the evening performance. Families will not have to request tickets. We will send home the two tickets on Monday, December 15 with the youngest and/or only child in each family. There will not be an opportunity to request additional tickets. Due to Fire Marshal regulations we cannot exceed the seating capacity of our gym. Please ensure you have your tickets to ensure admission into the performance. Preschool children will require a ticket too.
- To ensure that many of our students' important family members can attend a performance it would be helpful if we could collectively use the following guide lines. If you are able to attend the afternoon performance, please use your evening tickets for another family member, or if you don't need the tickets, please turn them into the office. If your family will not be able to attend the performance as you will be out of town, please return your tickets.



Winter Weather - Important Information

It is a priority for the Greater Victoria School District to communicate effectively to parents, students and community partners during inclement weather. With cooler temperatures in our forecast, the District would like to remind families of its inclement weather protocol and where to find information about the determination of school closures.

The District assesses weather conditions on a daily basis and puts every effort into making a determination by 6:30 a.m. of whether or not schools will remain open. The status of schools and transportation is then provided to local media and communicated to our community.

The District is regularly monitoring local weather conditions and Environment Canada's forecast, and will continue to do so over the weekend. Please stay connected with us for regular updates.


The Greater Victoria Region is broad and we understand that some areas may be more difficult to travel than others. It's always a parent's decision if you choose to keep your child home due to road conditions.

Kindergarten Registration - September 2026

Planning is already underway for Kindergarten registration. Children turning 5 years old in the 2026 calendar year are eligible for Kindergarten in September 2026. Registration week is Monday, January 26 through Friday, January 30, 2026.

Please read the following carefully for enrolment priorities as well as the documentation required to register.

Families are asked to register online for their catchment area school during registration week. If you currently have a student at Eagle View and will be registering a Kindergarten student but are not living in the Eagle View catchment you must register online for your catchment school and apply for a transfer to Eagle View.

To register you will need your child's birth certificate, Canadian Passport or landed immigrant authorization. You will need to provide **two** of the following documents for proof of residency (driver's license and utility bills will no longer be accepted):

Home owners

purchase agreement of home
current property tax statement
home owner's insurance
notice of assessment
a purchase agreement (w/subject removal & deposit receipt)

Renters


rental agreement signed by landlord & 2 of the following:
Canadian bank or credit card statement
BC vehicle registration
income tax statement
renter insurance documents
